Tasting Note

One sip of this crisp refreshing wine will leave you yearning for more. Delicate floral perfumes, vibrant lemon zest and juicy grapefruit tempt the nose. With time in the glass, faint expressions of ripe pineapple, lychee fruit and wet granite begin to surface. The balanced acidity strikes up front, lingers through the mid-palette and finishes strong with shades of honey and melon.

Derived from old vines and rooted in powdery Goldridge soil, this is a vibrant and refreshing white wine, bursting with aromas of honeysuckle, marshmallow and citrus zest. The 25% new French oak curves the aromas with hints of roast vanillin and balances the middle palate. A flood of lemon tart and fresh tropical fruit flavors hold steady for a lengthy finish. The acidity is threaded through this wine for a stimulating mouthfeel. Properly cellared, this wine will drink well to 2021 and beyond.

Tasting Note

This vintage carries a prodigious pedigree. Grown on the Bacigalupi Vineyard, this whole-berry, native yeast fermented red wine begins with brooding deep cherries, warm vanilla candle wax and fresh red berry bouquet. The flavors and mouthfeel lean towards the sensual side of the varietal. While drinking this wine in its infancy, there are fleshy plum and strawberry preserve flavors. Clean acidity stays on the top of the tongue for lift, while chewy and savory tannins wrap the sides of the palate and support the mouthfeel through the length of this unfiltered and unfined wine. Cellared properly, this wine will age well to 2025 and beyond.

The 2013 Syrah is ripe, round and powerful. With an intense black veil, this wine begins with a nose of blackberry, dried currant and hints of 60% new tight-grain French oak spices. Espresso and chocolate nuances persist in the underlay of the rich, coating mouthfeel of sweet black cherry, blackberry preserves and sturdy tannins. The mouthfeel is boastful and will develop nicely if cellared correctly. This age-worthy Syrah will be enjoyed through 2026 and beyond.

2013 ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Laki's Vineyard, Oak Knoll, Napa Valley



Tasting Note

In its sophomore season, this Cabernet is massive and rich, yet restrained. The color is deep and black and the nose is powerful and bold with explosive notes of chocolate, espresso, cherry reduction, raspberry preserves and overripe plum. There is a delightful cherry-drop in the heart of this wine. Like the jammy fruit center of a jelly doughnut, a very dense, bold and velvety red fruit flavor emerges as a delicious surprise. Flavors of cherry candy, blackberry, cassis, dried currant and espresso bean flood the mouth to find every last taste bud on the palate. The oak is rich and the mouthfeel is lavish. Firm tannins and a distinct sense of terroir create a sensational, well-rounded finish.

Striking in appearance, this Rosé begins with a delightful maraschino cherry hue. A bouquet of red rose water, grapefruit, chamomile and a hint of mint fills the glass. The mouthfeel is ripe with clean, bright acidity, just like a quality Rosé should be. Centered at its core, fresh strawberry and red fruit flavors pop for a zesty and crisp experience that lasts into the back palate. Overall, this Rosé is built a bit larger and bigger than some, but it comes through with a stylish kaleidoscope of fruit and freshness.

The first sip is striking as you swirl the wine over your tongue. An exciting arrangement of flavors emerge including blueberry, chocolate, espresso and red hard candy. The tannins and acidity are perfectly balanced, and the complexity of the palate will only build over time. Enjoy now through 2029 and beyond.

Farming and winemaking is in the blood of our Winemaker, Kirk Venge. A Napa Valley native, Kirk has been in the vineyard with his family from the impressionable age of four. His father, Nils Venge of Saddleback Cellars, is one of the foremost pioneers of the Napa Valley wine industry and the first American winemaker to receive 100-point score from renowned wine critic Robert Parker, Jr. Kirk grew up learning the rhythm of winemaking and became instilled with his father’s vision of excellence.

To support his familial ties to wine, Kirk has spent his lifetime working to become one of the most recognized and sought-after winemakers in Napa and Sonoma. Alongside his father, and through the years, Kirk drove the tractor, picked fruit at harvest and worked the bottling line. Eventually, he headed off to the prestigious University of California, Davis, to earn his degree in Viticulture and Enology. In 1999, Kirk moved to New Zealand to make iconic Sauvignon Blanc and later returned to Napa where he perfected the art of California Pinot Noir and Chardonnay at Mumm.

He is currently the proud owner and winemaker of Venge Estate Vineyards and Winery and the new label, Croix Estate. He is also the Consulting Winemaker for several boutique producers throughout Napa Valley.

Fate would have it that Eleven Eleven is his eleventh partnership.
